

## Knihověda.cz: The Portal of the History of Czech Book Culture up to 1800

- New platform for research into the Czech book culture
- Infrastructure offering data, texts and new research tools



- **Database of Bibliographic Sources**
  - Virtually merges **Knihopis českých a slovenských tisků**/Bibliography of Czech and Slovak Printed Books, **Bibliografie cizojazyčných bohemikálních tisků**/Bibliography of Foreign language Bohemica and **Soupis rukopisů**/Database of Manuscripts
  - Lists ca 60.000 editions of printed Bohemica up to 1800 and Bohemical manuscripts
- **Encyclopaedia of Books in the Czech Middle Ages and Early Modern Period**
  - Contains around 2.800 biographical, geographic and subject entries related to the Czech book culture
  - Covers the period from the Middle Ages to the beginning of the 19<sup>th</sup> century
- **Map of Printed Production in Bohemia and Moravia**
  - Visualisation of book printing in the Czech lands
  - Interactive research tool for analysis in terms of the linguistic, thematic and genre composition
